# **DANCE TEAM**

# **Dance Team Auditions:**

- Must wear a 2-piece outfit. (no pants or full tops)
- Must be able to confidently dance and move in your audition attire and shoes.
- You will be required to sign a release of liability, including photo and film.
- You may bring water bottles and snacks.
- Must have a valid photo ID.
- Appearance must be physically fit with hair and make-up glamorous. Each dancer should feel confident in their appearance.

## **Dance Team Requirements:**

- There is no maximum age; however, you must be at least 18 years of age by February 18, 2024.
- There is no height and weight requirement; however, must be physically fit.
- Must be able to attend ALL home games, practices, photo shoots, and full team engagements.
- Finalists will be asked about their ability to commit to a one-year contract.

# **Dance Team Audition Process:**

Saturday, February 17th: General Audition Day!

(Dancers will be judged on appearance, fitness, dance ability, style, strength and completion of movement, energy, and potential.)

• Throughout this day there will be various elements of dance, style, and fitness audition rounds. Sunday, February 18<sup>th</sup>: Finalist Audition Day!

(Dancers will be judged on speaking ability, energy, confidence, maturity, and over-all impression)

 Finalists will be asked to dress in Business attire and go through an interview for final eliminations.

# Dance Team - What to expect.

- Practices will be every Saturday with typical times of 9:00am to 1:00pm. (These times and dates are subject to change)
- Game Day activities will include extra time involving pre-game functions, media functions, and post-game activities.
- Compensation: The Dance Team members will be put on an "In-Season" monthly salary.
  - o \$1,000 per dancer per month
    - This breaks down to approximately: \$200 per home game, \$20 per hour for rehearsals and \$40 per hour for appearances.
    - The Salary requirement is for 6 Home games, Saturday practices and (5) total hours each month of public appearances.
  - Outside of the salary requirements:
    - Extra practices/rehearsals will be paid at \$20 per hour per dancer.
    - Extra public appearance hours will be paid at \$40 per hour per dancer.
- All practice wear, uniforms, game day attire, shoes, props, etc. will be supplied by the Nashville Kats organization.

# **MASCOT**

### **Mascot Auditions:**

- Must wear athletic wear and shoes.
- Must be able to confidently move in your audition attire and shoes.
- You will be required to sign a release of liability, including photo and film.
- You may bring water bottles and snacks.
- Must have a valid photo ID.
- Appearance must be physically fit. (Our costume restrictions are for height to be between 5'5" and 6')
- Please be prepared to submit video of other Mascot experience.

# **Mascot Audition Requirements:**

- There is no maximum age; however, you must be at least 18 years of age by February 18, 2024.
- Must be able to attend ALL home games, practices, photo shoots, and full team engagements.
- Finalists will be asked about their ability to commit to a one-year contract.

## **Mascot Audition Process:**

<u>Saturday, February 17<sup>th</sup></u>, will be the only day required to attend for the mascot audition process. (Mascots will be judged on personality, creativity, confidence, and over-all impression)

• Throughout this day there will be various tasks and challenges given to the mascots for ability to showcase their personal touch and thoughts on direction of the "Kool Kat" mascot.

# Mascot - What to expect.

- Practices and meetings will be approximately once a week. These dates and times will be determined upon the selection of mascot person.
- Game Day activities will include extra time involving pre-game functions, media functions, and post-game activities.
- Compensation:
  - \$50 per hour per mascot
- All practice wear, uniforms, game day attire, shoes, props, etc. will be supplied by the Nashville Kats organization.

# **HYPE-CREW**

# **Hype-Crew Auditions:**

- Must wear athletic wear and shoes.
- Must be able to confidently move in your audition attire and shoes.
- You will be required to sign a release of liability, including photo and film.
- You may bring water bottles and snacks.
- Must have a valid photo ID.
- Appearance must be physically fit.

# **Hype-Crew Audition Requirements:**

- There is no maximum age; however, you must be at least 18 years of age by February 18, 2024.
- Must be able to attend ALL home games, practices, photo shoots, and full team engagements.
- Finalists will be asked about their ability to commit to a one-year contract.

# **Hype-Crew Audition Process:**

<u>Saturday, February 17<sup>th</sup></u>, will be the only day required to attend for the Hype-Crew audition process. (Hype-Crew athletes will be judged on personality, fitness, creativity, confidence, and over-all impression)

• Throughout this day there will be various tasks and challenges given to the mascots for ability to showcase their strength, skills, personality, and creative direction.

## Hype-Crew – What to expect.

- Practices and meetings will be approximately once a week. These dates and times will be determined upon the selection of mascot person.
- Game Day activities will include extra time involving pre-game functions, media functions, and post-game activities.
- Compensation:
  - \$200 per HOME GAME per crew member.
- All practice wear, uniforms, game day attire, shoes, props, etc. will be supplied by the Nashville Kats organization.
